## Purpose of the Role:

Duties and Responsibilities Working with the RCM Manager,

- Design new exhibits at the Rideau Canal Museum (RCM)
- Prepare exhibit space (designing, painting, etc) and display exhibits


## Time Requirements:

- 10-15 hours per month (or more during exhibit times)


## Skills and Qualifications Required

- Volunteer must have interest and knowledge in canals, local history, canal history, exhibit design, museum exhibit techniques
- Excellent presentation skills
- Ability to work within a budget

- Enables for education of the general public re: local cultural history
