Guided Tours and Visitor Orientation

Purpose of the Role/Goals:

- To welcome visitors to the facility
- To provide guided tours of the facility
- To inform visitors of the features and functions of the museum
- To educate visitors on the history, construction, operation of the Rideau Canal and its builders

Location:

• RCM in Smiths Falls. Tours will be undertaken in the Rideau Canal Museum, and Smiths Falls Combined Locks

Duties and Responsibilities

- Initiate Contact with visitors to the museum
- Provide information, historical record, description of planning, and construction of the Rideau Canal, life during that time, key players, etc.
- Guide visitors through the museum, and combined locks and provide them with information/education regarding canal construction and life during the time of construction
- Provide visitors with data on current canal operations, facts and figures
- Provide information on Canada's first World Heritage Site
- Answer phones, work cash for paying visitors, organize upcoming tours,

Time Requirements:

- Required throughout the year most work will be done during the peak (summer) season
- Some tours needed during non peak season (Oct. Jan)
- 4 hours per day, 2 days per month or as desired

Skills and Qualifications Required

- Genuine interest in people, history, and local culture
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent memory for dates and details
- Ability to speak English mandatory, French an asset
