Project Assistant REAL Photographer

Purpose of the role

- To photographically record events, images, people, issues, happenings related to REAL's mandate, projects, programs, events
- To educate the public on environmental issues

Location

• Throughout REAL Region or home based

Duties and responsibilities may include:

- As directed, take pictures of features, events, people, issues, projects, sites that relate to REAL's interests
- Make photographs available for use in brochures, displays, publications, newsletters, etc
- Produce CD's of photos capturing aspects of REAL's mandate

Time requirements

- 5-10 hours per month
- Year round

Skills and qualifications

- Demonstrated ability to produce good quality digital photographs
- Willingness and ability to attend REAL events
- Knowledge of REAL's environmental programs, projects, language and local issues
- Excellent interpersonal skills
