

Radiant Rain Gardens



Rain gardens improve water quality by filtering runoff

A rain garden is built in a shallow depression on your property. Rain gardens intercept and collect rainwater runoff from roofs, driveways and yards, and allow it to infiltrate into the soil.

Rain gardens recharge groundwater aquifers, create habitat for birds and butterflies, and significantly reduce contamination from entering waterways.

Try using native plants like Canada Anemone, New England Aster, or Sweet Flag.
