## GET STARTED TODAY

### 1 Contact a Registered Energy Advisor (REA) to pre-qualify for your initial home assessment.

Contact one of the many available REAs who will take the time to pre-qualify you over the phone before your initial assessment is booked, listed at [enbridgesmartsavings.com/energyadvisor](http://enbridgesmartsavings.com/energyadvisor). Each Service Organization provides the same customer experience and will facilitate the rebate on your behalf. Upon successful completion, Enbridge Gas will include a \$550 reimbursement to help offset the cost of both energy assessments. This will be included in your final incentive cheque.

### 2 Successfully complete at least two qualifying upgrades.

When selecting your contractors, Enbridge recommends getting at least three quotes before making a decision. A list of contractors and qualifying upgrades can be found online at [enbridgesmartsavings.com/upgrades](http://enbridgesmartsavings.com/upgrades).

### 3 Complete a final home assessment with the same Registered Energy Advisor.

The final assessment takes approximately an hour and must take place within 120 days of your initial assessment. Your Registered Energy Advisor will then submit your paperwork to Enbridge, and you'll receive your incentive cheque by mail within 8-12 weeks.

- Install two or more qualifying upgrades

Only one enrollment for incentive per household is permitted. To find out if you qualify for incentives, an initial and final home energy assessment is required by an approved Registered Energy Advisor (REA). No more than 120 days between assessments is allowed. If more time is needed to complete your upgrades, simply speak with your REA and they can request an extension. The Home Efficiency Rebate is only available for residential detached homes, row towns and semis – no multi-residential buildings or condos.
