- You end up putting out bags shortly after the cleanup period.

## A Short History of Pitch In

Pitch In Canada began in British Columbia over 50 years ago. REAL volunteers have participated in cleanups since the group was established in 1989. In 2001 REAL began coordi-

# Pitch In Smiths Falls April 20—May 5, 2019

An annual community-wide litter cleanup. Help create a cleaner, greener Smiths Falls!



Pick up supplies beginning April 11 at the REAL Deal Store, 85 William St. W, Smiths Falls Open Thurs. to Sat 10—4

We will provide

- a bucket:
- garbage bags: some yellow and clear bags marked Pitch In, some plain
- a few grocery bags. It is easier to collect in small bags (especially for kids) and dump in the larger bag
- a few disposable gloves. Best to bring your own.

## **Please Go Out Prepared**

Dress appropriately for outdoor work:

- Sturdy shoes (no sandals), possibly even rubber boots
- Work gloves or garden gloves
- Long pants and hats
- Sunscreen
- Consider orange safety vests or reflective bands for visibility

### Also consider:

- A long stick with a nail in the end for snagging hard to reach garbage
- Water and/or treats for your group!
- Wipes or hand sanitizer.

## Where to Clean Up

This year REAL will not be matching groups to locations or recording where each group is working.

However, some groups have traditionally done certain areas (often schools or parks), so please consult our website so you can avoid those spots. There is lots of trash to go around!

Take a look at the area before taking a group there, and consider whether it is safe for children in your group.



## Think Safety at all Times

- Closely supervise your group, especially children.
- Do not allow children in wooded areas or near the water.
- Do not go on private property unless you have permission.
- Be cautious near parked cars, or along roads or driveways
- Do not attempt to move heavy or bulky items.
- Wash hands thoroughly after collecting garbage or before eating.

## **Avoid Handling These Items**

Exercise extreme caution with these items:

- condoms
- needles
- sharp or rusty metal
- anything submerged
- particularly submerged aerosol cans
- anything heavy



Consider having one person in your group be responsible for determining how to handle these items...

Let us know about any hazards after your cleanup and we will notify authorities. Your

#### What to Do

- Put all garbage in bags unless it is very bulky: tires, bikes, tents etc.
- Start with the yellow Pitch in bags, use plain bags if necessary.
- Place large recyclables in a separate clear Pitch In bag: cans, unbroken glass bottles, or plastic bottles ONLY.
- Do not put any other materials like paper wrappers, in the bag, it will not get recycled!
- If the recyclable item is very dirty, please just put it in the garbage bag.
- Broken glass can be put in the plastic bucket provided and left with the other garbage.
- When you are done, place the filled bags together in a pile near the road or parking lot so that town staff can access it by truck
- · Leave any large unbagged items beside it.
- Make sure a yellow Pitch in bag is clearly visible.

Please DO NOT bring the filled garbage bags to the REAL Deal!
