

Enbridge Gas Home Efficiency Rebate

Enbridge Gas customers can get **up to \$5,000 back** for making energy-efficient upgrades in their home.

- Complete a minimum of **two upgrades***.
- Home must be heated with a natural gas furnace or boiler.
- Each service organization provides the same customer experience and will be able to facilitate the rebate on the customer's behalf. Upon successful completion, Enbridge Gas will include a \$550 reimbursement on the customer's final incentive cheque to offset the cost of both energy assessments.
- Maximum total Enbridge Gas rebate is \$5,000.**
- All work and final assessment must be completed within **120 days of initial assessment.**



Enbridge Gas incentives: at least two of these upgrades must be undertaken to qualify for incentives*

Air sealing

- \$150** • For reaching 10% above target on report
- \$100** • For reaching target on report

Note: Baseline calculation is done during the initial assessment.

Attic insulation

- \$500** • For increasing attic insulation to at least R60 from R35 or less
- For increasing cathedral/flat roof insulation by at least R14

Note: Minimum 20% of total ceiling area must be upgraded. Rebates are pro-rated based on the total ceiling area % upgraded.

Basement insulation

- \$1,000** • For adding at least R23 to 100% of basement
- \$800** • For adding at least R23 to 100% of crawl space wall
- \$500** • For adding at least R12 to 100% of basement
- \$450** • For adding at least R24 to 100% of floor above crawl space
- \$400** • For adding at least R10 to 100% of crawl space wall

Note: Minimum 20% of total basement wall area must be upgraded. Rebates are pro-rated based on the total combined % area upgraded. Crawl space and floor above crawl space are considered one measure. The maximum total rebate for basement insulation is \$1,000.

Exterior wall insulation

- \$2,000** • Add at least R20 to 100% of building
- \$1,500** • Add at least R9 to 100% of building to achieve a minimum of R12
- \$1,000** • Add at least R3.8 to 100% of building to achieve a minimum of R12

Note: Minimum 20% of total wall area must be upgraded. Rebates are pro-rated based on the total wall area % upgraded. Homes with less than 2 x 4 structure are exempt from R12 minimum with photo documentation of wall structure.

Furnace/boiler

Combi unit will only count as one measure

- \$1,000** • For replacing a natural gas boiler that is < 90% AFUE with a condensing natural gas boiler that is 90% AFUE or higher
- \$500** • For replacing a natural gas furnace that is < 96% AFUE with a condensing natural gas furnace that is 96% AFUE or higher

* If you are upgrading your natural gas furnace, you must complete at least 2 additional upgrades (a total of 3 upgrades or more) to qualify for the Home Efficiency Rebate.

Water heater

- \$200** • For replacing existing natural gas water heater with 0.80 EF or higher **tank** type ENERGY STAR® qualified natural gas water heater
- For replacing existing natural gas water heater with 0.90 EF or higher **tankless** type ENERGY STAR® qualified natural gas water heater

Window/door/skylight

- \$40** • For each window, door or skylight replaced with an ENERGY STAR® qualified model

Additional bonus incentives:

If you install more than two upgrades, you also qualify for a \$250 bonus for each additional upgrade installed—up to a maximum total incentive of \$5,000.

For example:

- Install 3 upgrades**—customer will receive an additional **\$250**
- Install 4 upgrades**—customer will receive an additional **\$500**
- Install 5 upgrades**—customer will receive an additional **\$750**

To qualify for the Home Efficiency Rebate, homeowners must also agree not to participate in any other gas or building envelope rebate(s) offered by parties outside of Enbridge Gas Inc. between the initial and final assessments. Natural gas fuel savings are based on approved modelling software. Only one enrolment for incentive per household is permitted. To find out if you qualify for incentives, an initial and final home energy assessment is required by an approved Registered Energy Advisor (REA). No more than 120 days between assessments is allowed. If more time is needed to complete your upgrades, simply speak with your REA and they can request an extension. Please contact one of the Enbridge Gas approved service organizations for further information. The Home Efficiency Rebate is only available for residential detached or semi-detached houses, mobile homes (with permanent foundation) or row townhouses—no multi-residential buildings or condos.
