

Yard Sales Associate

The REAL Deal Reuse Store operated by the Rideau Environmental Action League requires a Yard Sales Associate with flexibility to work a minimum of two days a week, Wednesday through Saturday, starting immediately.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Assess incoming donations for acceptance and for resale
- Weigh and record all incoming donations.
- Clean, price and display yard and dome materials, collaborate on the assessing and pricing of more valuable items.
- Open and close yard, dome, gates, trailer, garbage bin, and electronic waste.
- Maintain the organization and cleanliness of the yard and store as required
- Relay sales and payments to instore cashier and/or manager.
- Assist with other tasks as requested, e.g. moving large items within store or yard maintenance.
- Work in a friendly, positive way to assist customers with their donations and purchases.
- Report to the in-store manager.
- Engage and direct any volunteers in a positive and respectful manner.
- Work as a team with another sales associate and any other staff or volunteers.
- Adhere to the organization's policies and health and safety program.
- Practice sound environmental practices.

Physical Requirements and Qualifications

- Work is mainly outdoors in all weather unloading and moving materials.
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
- Retail experience and knowledge of renovations materials an asset.
- Experience supporting and directing volunteers an asset.
- Show interest and dedication to REAL's reuse and environmental mission.
- Ability to work with changing priorities.
- Be motivated and self-directed but also be able to accept and give instruction and direction.

This position pays \$15.00 an hour for 15- 20 hrs per week. Must be available to work Wed., Thurs., Fri and Saturday, 9 - 5:30. Our immediate need is for someone to work all day Wednesday and Thursday.
