

Potential Pitch-In Locations – March 2026

These are just some suggestions of areas from past years that have required cleanups. Even your own neighbourhood can be a good choice.

Area 1: South of Rideau River, Lombard Street

Ferrara Drive from stop sign behind the YIG continuing to the corner of Ferrara Drive and Canadian Tire lane

Ferguson Street from corner of Ferrara Drive towards Tim Hortons (both sides)

Lombard Street from Starbucks towards Canadian Tire alongside of Lombard

Lombard Street from Walmart towards the Best Western and KFC

Intersection of Lombard and Abbot Street (all four corners)

Victoria Park

Area 2: South of River, Brockville and Jasper Streets

Behind Brockville/Broadview mini mall/ to high school

Behind Chambers St Mall in front of Healey's Bus Depot and Centre Street

Woods behind Heritage House (only do as a group)

Behind Curling Club near the off leash dog park, Gleeson Park to Jasper Avenue

Along Jasper Ave (rock wall) to Vincent Street

Jasper Road from Old Sly's to RR track – E side near ball diamonds and west side

Jasper Ave along Lower Reach Park, Old Sly's Rd to Broadview

Eric Hutchinson Rd (esp intersection with Jasper Ave.)

Hwy 29 Between Mausoleum and Cemetery

Area 3: North of Rideau River, William and Cornelia

Ball Diamonds and Play area Behind the Youth Arena – skateboard park and tennis courts

Cornelia from Perth & SF District Hospital to Garden Market

William St. West (Abbott St to County Rd #43) both sides

Elmsley from Cornelia to Beckwith

Maizie Street

Area 4: North of Rideau River, Downtown

Downtown – Beckwith/Elmsley to Chambers

Behind the Tap House and around (old) Water Treatment Plant

Centennial Park and base of old water tower

Area 5: North of Rideau, Elmsley to Chambers

Victoria Ave from Lee Hotel to William (is worse towards William)

Rideau Ave. North (by National Grocers) (very large, deep ditches and wet – do as a group)

Ann Street

Alexander Park and streets around it

Montague St/Helen to Foot subway.

Area 6: North of River, South of Chambers

Hyland and Corbett Parks

Empress Avenue

Sussex
